



## **Laboratory and Pathology Services include:**

**Pathology Services-** Provided by Associated Pathologists and Medical Center of Central Georgia, Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine

Local Access -On-site immunohistochemistry (can improve TAT by 24 - 48 hrs. minimum)
-FNA by cytopathologist available on request (e.g. initial or repeat / follow up LN aspiration for flow cytometry)

**Experience-** On- site board certified cytopathologist and hematopathologist

**Availability of Resources-** Overnight Intra-departmental consultation available with ~ 50 colleagues for virtually all pathologic specialties.

**Courier Service-** Couriers are available daily Monday – Friday at office preferred times for specimen pick-ups. Scheduled weekend pickups available.

**Client Services-** Experienced Clinical Laboratory Scientists handle technical support. Additional resources include Clinical Laboratory Specialists, PHD chemistry professionals and pathologists.

**Patient Service Centers-** 5 convenient lab collection sites located in Macon. No appointment necessary. Walk-ins welcome! Free parking.

**Remote Result Reporting-** remote fax is provided to facility for reporting of routine and STAT results. Print times are scheduled according to client request.

**Web Based Orders and Results**- Lab Valet system offers continuous access to results, onsite order entry and capability to interface results into Electronic Medical Records.
